Everything You Need to Vote

Find out when to vote and where your polling station is. Learn what form of ID to bring with you on Election Day.

Voter ID requirements: Each state sets its own voter ID rules. And most require voters to bring identification to vote in person. Know the voter ID laws in your state before going to the polls.

Find your polling place: Your polling place is where you go to vote in local, state, and federal elections. Find out where yours is located, its hours, and if you can change your polling place.


Use voter guides and sample ballots to learn about candidates: Voter guides and sample ballots include the candidates and the state or local issues up for a vote. Reviewing them before you go to the polls can help you decide who to vote for.

- Check Your Registration**
Not sure if you're registered to vote? We'll help you check and register if you can.
- Register To Vote**
It takes less than 2 minutes to register.
- Vote By Mail**
Can't or don't want to vote in person on Election Day? Request an absentee ballot.
- See What's On Your Ballot**
We'll show you what's on your local ballot and help you make a voting plan you can take with you to the polls.
- Get Election Reminders**
We'll remind you when and what you need to vote, so that you never miss an election again.
- Pledge To Register**
Too young to vote? Pledge to register and we'll text you a reminder on your 18th birthday.

The Electoral College Explained

Electoral votes are allocated among the States based on the Census. Every State is allocated several votes equal to the number of Senators and Representatives in its U.S. Congressional delegation—two votes for its Senators in the U.S. Senate plus several votes equal to the number of its Congressional districts. Under the 23rd Amendment of the Constitution, the District of Columbia is allocated three electors and treated like a State for purposes of the Electoral College. Each State (which includes the District of Columbia for the Electoral College) decides how to appoint its electors; however, they must do so according to law enacted before Election Day. Currently, all States use the popular vote results from the November general election to decide which political party chooses the individuals who are appointed.
