## REQUIREMENTS

### Application

Completed student information with applicant's signature.

### Transcript

A high school or college transcript is required. Transcript should have a school administrator/counselor's signature or seal.

### Personal Statement

The applicant must complete a **one-page maximum** personal statement themselves. The personal statement should explain how the scholarship funds will help achieve your education and career goals. Explain in detail the circumstances that impact paying for college for this upcoming year. Please include information about the college aid awarded and other sources of funding available or anticipated.

### Letter of Recommendation

A letter from a non-family member is required. The letter may be from a counselor, teacher (current or former), employer, professor, church official, or member of the community. The letter should be included in the application packet and not mailed separately. The recommender should include the relationship to the applicant, length of time having known the applicant, and obstacles the applicant has overcome.

### Photo

Submit a professional headshot or senior portrait. Photo should not be a "proof" and be of good quality. The photo may be sent as a .jpg file. *By submitting a photo, you permit Generations for America to use it in all printed, social media, and electronic announcements.*

*The application and supporting documents must be **RECEIVED by Monday, February 2, 2026.** You will receive an email confirming the receipt of your application. Applications submitted after the deadline or incomplete applications will not be considered.*
